

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**  
**for**  
**2026 Pavement Preservation Project**

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the City of Mill Creek for construction of the 2026 Pavement Preservation. Work to be performed includes, but is not limited to: a combination of pavement planing, HMA Overlay, curb ramp retrofit, utility casting adjustment, monument replacement, pavement markings, permanent signing, temporary traffic control, detours, surface restoration, and miscellaneous items as further shown, described, and indicated in the Contract Documents, and other work all in accordance with the attached Contract Plans, these Special Provisions and the Standard Specifications.

Bid proposals will be received only at the City of Mill Creek City Hall South, 15728 Main Street. By 2:00 PM, Pacific Standard Time, on April 30, 2026. Proposals received after the time fixed for opening will not be considered.

Bids will be publicly opened, read aloud, and tabulated shortly after the time and date stated above. This bid opening will take place in the City Council Chambers located in City Hall South, 15728 Main Street, Mill Creek, Washington. Attendance at the bid opening is not required.

Free-of-charge access to project bid documents is provided to Prime Bidders, Subcontractors, and Vendors by going to [www.bxwa.com](http://www.bxwa.com) and clicking on "Posted Projects", "Public Works", and "City of Mill Creek". This online plan room provides Bidders with fully usable online documents with the ability to: download, view, print, order full/partial plan sets from numerous reprographic sources, and a free online digitizer/take-off tool. It is recommended that Bidders "Register" in order to receive automatic e-mail notification of future addenda and to place themselves on the "Self-Registered Bidders List". Bidders that do not register will not be automatically notified of addenda and will need to periodically check the on-line plan room for addenda issued on this project. The City of Mill Creek, in accordance with Title VI and Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat.252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4, Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, and RCW 49.60.180(1) hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises as defined at 49 CFR Part 26 will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, or sexual orientation in consideration for an award. The City of Mill Creek hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure

that in any contract entered into, pursuant to this advertisement, minority and women's business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this Advertisement for Bids.

All work performed on the project will be subject to State of Washington prevailing wage rates.

Each bid proposal shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in certified check, cashier's check, postal money order, or bid bond in an amount equal to at least five (5) percent of the amount of such bid proposal. Make checks payable to the City of Mill Creek. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance and payment bond within the time stated in the Specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Mill Creek.

The City of Mill Creek reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive irregularities in the bid or the bidding. No bidder may withdraw their proposal after the time set for the bid opening thereof, or before award of contract, unless said contract award is delayed for a period exceeding sixty (60) calendar days.
