
BURK PLACE S.ON NOISIVID

No. 2-J, less the east 320.0 feet thereof; and is a re-plat of Lot 1, Heatherwood Garden Tracts Division No. 2, according to the plat thereof as recorded in Volume 10 of Plats on page 19, records of Snohomish county, Washington, less the east 300.0 feet, and less the west 80.0 feet of the east 380.0 feet of the south 82.82 feet thereof. Any enclosing of drainage waters in culverts or drains or re-routing thereof across any lot as may be undertaken by or for the owner of any lot, shall be done by and at the expénse of such owner.
